Kerem Adventure Camp is closely monitoring the latest developments in Western Australia regarding the coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak and following the direction of our state and federal health officials.

We would like to take this opportunity to inform you of the precautions we are taking in response to this serious situation.

Kerem Adventure Camp is updating its response plan that will guide our actions in preparation for and response to the COVID-19 threat in Western Australia, ensuring our Guests and Team members are safe, while minimising the impact on operations. The venue will continue to operate normal opening hours in line with the current advice of the WA and Federal Department of Health.

We are closely monitoring the developments daily and have increased precautionary measures including:

- Advanced cleaning protocols for touched surfaces, such as door handles, hand-rails, and restrooms.
- All ablutions continue to be disinfected twice daily and cleaning has been increased in the dining and kitchen areas following every meal.
- Conveniently located hand-sanitiser (when available) for use by Guests and Team members in addition to the soap available at all basins.
- Anti-bacterial air freshener is available in all dormitories and on request.
- Providing recommendations to Guests and Team members to help prevent the spread of infection; including regular hand washing, coughing and sneezing into your bent elbow and avoiding close contact with anyone showing symptoms of respiratory illness. Instructional, hand washing, signage is also visible throughout the venue.
- We are being vigilant with monitoring the well-being of our Team in line with official advice provided by the Australian Government in relation to self-quarantine and testing requirements for individuals at high risk due to travel or other factors.
- We have cancelled all non-essential work-related travel outside of Western Australia.
- We ask that all Guests at Kerem who show symptoms of respiratory illness return home immediately and seek medical attention. Additionally, Camp coordinators are encouraged to ensure nobody with symptoms of respiratory illness attend the camp and that no Guests have travelled internationally within the last 14 days.



We will continue to monitor the situation and provide further updates if required.
